## ARP ESSER Plan – Latta Public Schools

Question 1: How will the LEA use the 20% of funds reserved under section 2001(e)(1) of the ARP Act to address the academic impact of lost instructional time through the implementation of evidence-based interventions, such as summer learning or summer enrichment, extended day, comprehensive afterschool programs, or extended school year?

Remainder of ESSER III Funds will be spend on some or all of the following:

- Salaries
- Utilities (Gas, Water, & Electric)
- Replacement of outdated HVAC Units
- Professional Development tied to COVID and Learning Loss
- Stipends for Staff to Attend Aforementioned Professional Development
- Smart TV's for Classrooms
- Chromebooks/Laptops for Students
- Laptops/Desktop Computers for Teachers
- Adaptive technology for students with disabilities to assist with remote learning
- Mastery Prep ACT software

Question 3: How will the LEA ensure that interventions, including but not limited to those implemented under section 2001(e)(1) of the ARP Act addressing the academic impact of lost instructional time, will respond to the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students, and particularly those students disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, including students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care, and migratory students?

- Through benchmarking and other assessments, Latta Public Schools will survey student learning loss and other needs of all students, particularly those who have been disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Data-driven decisions will be made regarding best practices to assist all students.
